**1. ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The AJS Moto Trial Club of SA Inc., hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct Frank Tuck Moto Trial, on Sunday the 21<sup>st</sup> March 2010.

**2. JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Open Permit Number C10053 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Open Senior/Junior, Restricted National Licences and Practice Permit Number N10155 open to holders of the above plus Recreation and One Event Licences.
- 2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

**BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.**

**3. ENTRIES:**

- 3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> March 2010.
- 3.2. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.3. Entries are to be sent to: AJS Moto Trial Club c/o -- C/O PO BOX 505 GLENSIDE SA 5065
- 3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES MAY RECEIVE A 10 POINT PENALTY AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE AJS MOTO TRIAL CLUB OF SA INC.**

**4. INSURANCE:**

- 4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.
- 4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

**5. MEDICAL SERVICES:**

First Aid volunteer will be available on site. No Doctor, Paramedic or Ambulance will be in attendance.

**6. ENTRY FEE:**

- 6.1. Solo \$40, Sidecar \$50, Junior \$15, Family \$50 (Parent and resident students).
- 6.2. Payment by Cash, Cheque or Money Order only. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT. If paying on the day is selected you will still be liable for the entry fee if you do not attend.**
- 6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the AJS Moto Trial Club of SA Inc.

**7. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:**

Solo A, B, C, Masters, Veteran, Post Classic, Clubman, Junior, Junior B, Sidecar A, B  
Veteran and Post Classic are run over C Grade Lines.  
Junior B is designed for entry level riders and is suitable for small wheel bikes.

**8. AWARDS:**

Trophies to placegetters dependant on number of competitors in each class. Recreational and One Event Licence holders may ride any grade section for no awards.

**9. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:**

- 9.1 To constitute a class, the number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be three.
- 9.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

**10. RIDING FORMAT:**

- 10.1 The Trial may be run as a Half Day ride or an all day ride using the Buddy. Riders to Observe when and as required.
- 10.2 The Trial will be run under "TRIALS" rules.

**11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:**

- 11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Moto-Trials competition.
- 11.2. Machines and competitors must report to machine examination no later than 9:45 am and produce their current competition licence, recreation licence or one event licence. There is a penalty for lateness, 1 point per minute as per GCR's, penalty shall not apply if you are in line to be examined at time cut off.
- 11.3. No bikes are to be ridden before machine examination or during the lunch break.
- 11.4. No bikes are to be ridden in the car park area. Maintenance may be done in the car park area provided that the motorcycle is pushed to and from the car park area. Refuelling only in the Refuelling area and the use of the supplied Enviromat is required. Penalties apply for failure to observe these rules, maximum 100 points or exclusion.
- 11.5. Riders must present their scorecard to the scorer at the completion of each lap (Penalty for each unattempted section is 5 points)
- 11.6. Substitution of Motorcycle may be allowed, subject to the approval of the Clerk Of Course or Steward.
- 11.7. Observers and Officials may ride to and from their sections or as and when required to perform their duty.

**12. NAME PLATES:**

- 12.1. All bikes will have name plates which MUST comply with the GCR's.

**13. RIDERS' BRIEFING:**

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of riding, which ALL competitors MUST attend.

**14. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:**

- 14.1. All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

**15. CODE OF CONDUCT:**

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

Also, this event will be deemed to be finished at the completion of the riding time or 30 minutes after the last rider completes the course.
